### Rules:

1. **Entries should be MAILED TO:** Grimes County Fair Association, P.O. Box 435, Anderson, TX 77830.
2. Class breaks are as follows.
  - a. September – December 2011
  - b. May – August 2011
  - c. January – April 2011
  - d. September - December 2010
  - e. May – August 2010
  - f. January – April 2010
  - g. September – December 2009

The beef committee reserves the right to break larger number classes.

3. The Bred and Owned Class will have no entry fee.
4. There will be four divisions shown: American, British, European, and Commercial. There will be a Champion and Reserve Champion Overall and a Champion and Reserve Champion Bred and Owned.
5. In the Registered Divisions (American, British, and European) one registered heifer will constitute a breed. Heifers must meet breed standards to compete in these divisions. Heifers must be registered in the exhibitor's name and you must present registration papers at the time of check – in.
6. In the Commercial Division there will be two breed classes:
  - a. ABC – American Influence
  - b. AOB – All other Breeds

Heifers will be classified by someone agreed upon by the judge and committee.

6. Non – registered heifers are not eligible. Heifers must show on the registration papers, the exhibitor as the sole breeder. Other family members or ranch names do not qualify. Bred and owned division will consist of one class with only a Grand and Reserve Champion being selected.
8. Showmanship will be divided into three groups:
  - a. Junior – 11 years and under
  - b. Intermediate – 12 to 14 years
  - c. Senior – 15 years and older
  - d. Ages will be determined as of January 1, 2012
9. Cattle must remain on the fairgrounds until proper release time, unless approved by the committee chairman.
10. Only cattle that are entered and eligible to show will be allowed to stall at the fairgrounds.
